

Bahamas Visa Requirements/Instructions

Individuals who require a Bahamas Visa for visiting The Bahamas (find list here (insert link to list)) can apply in person at any Embassy or Consulate General of the Commonwealth of The Bahamas, or by mailing the required documents. Please note that The Bahamas Consulate General, Miami only accepts applications within the United States. See below for a complete list of requirements.

- a. Completed Application Form (download here)
- b. Valid Passport
- c. Two (2) Passport sized photos no more than six months old
- d. Travel/Cruise itinerary or flight itinerary and hotel accommodations. If staying with family members or friends, a letter of invitation accompanied by proof of legal status in The Bahamas (i.e. residency permit, work permit, naturalization certificate or Bahamian passport). Letter of invitation is to include names of the invited guests, address where guests will reside, length of stay in The Bahamas and must be signed
- e. Valid United States entry visa or valid work authorization card. Please note students must present I-20. TPS documents are also accepted as valid permission to re-enter the United States
- f. Fee of \$55.00. Cash or money order accepted. For mail-in applications, only money orders are accepted. Money orders should be made payable to The Bahamas Consulate General
- g. *If you are mailing an application, please include a prepaid return envelope from the carrier of your choice

Additional Information

For visitors travelling on private aircraft or vessels, travel itinerary/flight plan should be accompanied by the Captain or Pilot's License and Vessel or Aircraft Registration.

For crew applying for multiple entry visas, application should include all of the above required documents along with the Captain or Pilot's License, Crew List and letter from the employer/captain that outlines employment.
